The programme is designed to consistently bring you closer to your application goal, so active participation and the completion of personal work tasks are required. Please allow enough time each day to participate in the live webinars and work on your individual tasks. The total workload per programme part is at least 12 hours.

Personal Atmosphere

A group of maximum 12 participants will ensure a personal atmosphere during the seminar. One-on-one exchange with the trainer and small group work with max. 4 participants allows an individual and intensive learning environment.

Extended Content Availability

All published self-study courses are accessible for three months and can be extended by another three months period upon request without any costs. You will receive detailed presentation PDFs, handouts and work sheets which helps you to remember the content lifelong.

Bilingual German-English

The career programmes are offered alternately in English and German (according to the event title). This means that in an English session, the presentation language during the live webinars is English, but the presentation slides and handouts as well as communication with the trainer are available in German. All self-study courses are also available in German.

Like-Minded Participants

The course programme is exclusively for doctoral students and postdocs who wish to end their academic careers in the near future (ideally within 6 months) and move into the private sector.
